Please submit a brief narrative (500 words or less) describing the nominee's achievements, contributions, and impact on emergency medicine.

Most emergency physicians are content to sit in their EDs and wait for critically ill patients to come to them. But not Dr. Nusbaum. He has made it abundantly clear from his earliest days in emergency medicine that he wants to optimize the care patients receive long before they cross the threshold into a hospital.

Dr. Nusbaum initially did residency at Mount Sinai Hospital, where he was already recognized as the resident who contributed the most to prehospital care throughout residency (the Resident EMS Service Award). He immediately continued his education as an EMS Fellow at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. He subsequently began working as the Medical Command Physician for UPMC and as EMS Medical Director for TEN different fire departments and EMS agencies. That's not a typo - literally 10!

I bring this up to underscore how fortunate Baltimore was to have an EMS physician with this degree of passion and experience transition here in 2021 when Dr. Nusbaum started working at the University of Maryland Midtown Campus. Of course, pure clinical work could only interest him for so long and over the past several years Dr. Nusbaum has taken on increasing roles throughout the state. Notably this includes as Assistant Medical Director of the Baltimore City Fire Department and as Medical Director of the Baltimore County Fire Department.

This means I'm just as likely to find him standing in 5 inches of snow during a 4-alarm fire in Dundalk or teaching one of his many continuing education sessions for EMTs and paramedics, as I am to find him saving lives in the ED at Midtown. It's worth noting that even in his downtime, Dr. Nusbaum is not fully satisfied and wants to help further advance the field of EMS, reviewing papers for the specialty journal "Prehospital Emergency Care".

In summary, Dr. Nusbaum has demonstrated unwavering dedication to emergency medicine services, within which he provides critical leadership. It is my sincere hope that you will recognize his many contributions with this award.
