

Dr. Gingold is an Associate Professor in Emergency Medicine in the University of Maryland Department of Emergency Medicine. He is the track leader for the University of Maryland Residency Program lecture series on Social Medicine and Behavioral Health. He has given several presentations at AAEM, SAEM, and ACEP scientific assemblies. Dr. Gingold served as the Medical Director for the Baltimore City Mobile Integrated Health program and is now the Assistant Medical Director for Population Health at Baltimore City Fire Department, working with the city EMS, police, and mental health agencies to improve quality care delivery to patients in mental health crisis, resulting in being named the MD ACEP Chapter EMS Physician of the Year in 2024. He was co-chair of the UMMS committee tasked with developing and implementing the UMMS ED buprenorphine initiation protocol. He is now a member of the steering committee for BCORE (Baltimore Comprehensive Overdose Response to End the Epidemic), a city-wide collaborative working to improve coordination and access to treatment for patients with opioid use disorder.
